This past month has been full, encouraging, and filled with reminders that God is still opening doors.

We are now fully booked for June and July as we travel to meet with potential church partners! We are already on the road, making the most of each opportunity God gives us. Along the way, we are enjoying time together as a family, seeing new places, meeting new people, and continuing to share the burden and vision of Marines to Missions everywhere we go.

In Sulawesi, materials have been purchased for what we have lovingly called our new “1,000-square-foot mansion.” When we arrive in Indonesia for our August and September survey trip, we will confirm the final plans and site so construction can begin. This is another exciting step forward in preparing for the growing needs of the ministry there!



We also received incredible news from Tondano. Some of the children from the orphanage went out evangelizing, and through their witness, 14 people accepted Jesus Christ as their Lord and Saviour. What a blessing to see the very children being reached and disciplined now going out and sharing the gospel with others.



The orphanage was also able to purchase a four-wheeler for the children to enjoy, thanks to the generosity of a faithful donor. It may seem like a simple thing, but to the kids, it is a source of joy, laughter, and memories they will not soon forget.



In Bali, the churches that have been planted are packed full. God continues to bless the evangelistic spirit of these congregations, and many people from Muslim and Hindu backgrounds have come to faith in Christ. We are still praying and planning toward the construction of another church building to help accommodate the growing number of believers.



Funding also continues to come in for the new school facility in Sulawesi. Once the fundraising goal is reached, this building will allow us to host elementary, middle, and high school students in one place. This means that no longer will our children have to attend Muslim-centered schooling for middle and high school, but will instead continue to expand on their Christian-based education through their primary school years! This will also free up the current elementary school space, allowing us to house an additional 25 orphans.

And the timing could not be better! Later this month, 9 orphans from Borneo are scheduled to be flown into our orphanage in Sulawesi. Please pray for them to have an easy transition and to feel welcomed and loved by everyone there.

We are watching God provide, open doors, save souls, and grow the work in ways only He can. Thank you for praying, giving, encouraging, and partnering with us as we continue forward.
